WORLD BOOK DAY - Thursday 7th March 2024

HEADLICE

For some families this is a very frustrating problem. Regardless of how well an individual family responds to an outbreak and which products are used, the infestation reoccurs.

Nowadays, the Local Health Authority advise against schools from sending out individual letters notifying parents of head lice. The only way to eradicate the problem is for the whole school to be 'free from head lice' and parents to continually check their children's hair.

Combing through wet hair regularly with a fine comb and conditioner is said to be the most effective preventative available. Please use a fine comb on your child's wet hair as frequently as possible.

Reminders like this will reappear periodically indicating that headlice have been recently reported in the school.


