Next Friday Kingsmoor will be 'running' our Race for life in aid of Cancer research. This event was due to place last year and unfortunately had to be postponed so I am thrilled that we will finally be able to put the race on – raising money for this fantastic cause which is certainly dear to my heart and I'm sure many of yours.

The plan!

All children to wear PE kit on Friday – proper trainers/daps must be worn. They can also wear a pink t-shirt or accessory – hat/wig/ in the cancer research colours if they would like.

Children must have a water bottle with them in school this day.

Please ensure sun cream is applied prior to the start of school and a hat in the event of hot weather.

As per the dance practises, parents are invited in to support your child in their race should you wish and are available to do so. (A maximum of two per family.) See below for timings. Please vacate the site/local area once the race has completed. Please wear masks when on the school site and close to other adults/pupils. Hand sanitiser will be placed at the school entrance for parental use upon arrival.

Depending on the age of the child, races will either be on the school site (Classes 1, Y1 and Y2– using our track, or venturing off down the King's Sedgemoor drain for the KS2 pupils. (Y3/4/5/6)

Pupils are being encouraged to **'do their best.'** We have talked today about different abilities and how some people may prefer to have a little jog and then a little walk – equally others who will feel more confident running the whole way. Fortunately, we have a cross section amongst our staff who are all keen and able to do their best too! We will be with the pupils supporting/running/jogging/walking and encouraging all along the way. The idea is to have fun and raise money for a fantastic charity!



Timings of the day



Children to arrive at school at normal times in PE kits.

9:15-9:45 - Assembly for all pupils – with a representative from cancer research who will be talking to the children about the charity and kick starting our day.

9:15	Assembly for whole school pupils only on the playground
9:50	YEAR 2 Parents to arrive onto playground – departing by 10:20
10:00 – 10:30	YEAR 2 Track race – pupils watch and support
10:30	YEAR 5 and 6 Parents arrive
	Race to start on School track and then progress to the cycle path on King Sedgemoor Drain – arriving back at school. (Social Distancing/bubbles will apply – it may be possible to spectate on the cycle path)
10:45	YEAR 5/6 Race start time
1:00	Year 3 and 4 parents arrive - Race to start on School track and then progress the same as Year 5 and 6
1:15	YEAR 3/4 Race start time
2:15	Year 1 parents arrive
2:30	YEAR 1 Race start time – Year 1 pupils can go home if parents are here after the race.
2:45	Class 1 parents arrive
3:00	Class 1 Race start time
