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AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS – after half term

PICK UP FOR THURSDAY AFTERSCHOOL CLUBS ARE AS FOLLOWS

Could you please wear face masks when on the school premises and please arrive no earlier than 4.25pm – thank you

SCHOOL UNIFORM, PE KIT AND PRESENTATION

We will continue to allow pupils to come to school in their PE kit on PE days for the next half term to save changing in the school. However, now that the shops have re-opened **could you please ensure that your children come to school in the Kingsmoor PE uniform**, details as below.

- Plain white t-shirts/Kingsmoor logo t-shirt (with blue school cardigan or sweatshirt dependant on weather)
- Grey, Black or Navy shorts or leggings/joggers (dependant on weather)
- Daps or trainers

Assorted football shirts, multi-coloured and logo covered kit and hoodies should only be worn for after school clubs.

A reminder also of the Kingsmoor school uniform

Girls Grey Skirts, Pinafores, Grey trousers, White Blouse/Poloshirt, Royal blue Jumper, Cardigan, Blue checked Dress

Boys Grey Shorts/Trousers, White Shirt/Poloshirt, Royal blue Jumper

For reasons connected with health and safety the school discourages the wearing of jewellery. If children have pierced ears only **small studs** should be worn in school. These should be removable by pupils (if needed) for PE, including swimming and remain their responsibility. Also rings, bracelets or necklaces should not be worn in school. HEADLICE

For some families this is a very frustrating problem. Regardless of how well an individual family responds to an outbreak and which products are used, the infestation reoccurs if other parents are not checking their child's hair. Nowadays, the Local Health Authority advise against schools from sending out individual letters notifying parents of head lice.

The only way to eradicate the problem is for the whole school to be 'free from head lice' and parents to continually check their children's hair.

Combing through wet hair regularly with a fine comb and conditioner is said to be the most effective preventative available. Please use a fine comb on your child's wet hair as frequently as possible.

Reminders like this will reappear periodically indicating that headlice have been recently reported in the school.

Please check your children over the half term and help us to be "head lice free".
